

Scripture Memory Cards

Memorizing Scripture is a powerful tool against the enemy and to help you live a life of godliness. You will find that, years down the road, these verses come back to you and help you through hard times.

There are lots of methods to help you memorize Scripture. One of the best and easiest is to keep these cards with you and handy so that you can look at them throughout the day. You can also post them places you'll see them a lot, like in your bedroom. These cards are 3x5 inches, which is the size of a standard index card. These memory cards are here in both the TLV and ESV versions. While we use TLV in the book, you are encouraged to memorize Scripture in whatever version you use the most.
